

## For all Students & Staff using the Discipline of Biomedical Science

### Anatomy or Microbiology Laboratories:

- A protective gown or lab coat **MUST** be worn
- Latex or vinyl examination gloves **MUST** be worn when examining wet specimens (Anatomy Labs).
- Gloves **MUST** be disposed of in the designated receptacles
- **NO** photography is allowed in the laboratories
- **CLOSED** footwear is mandatory for both Anatomy and Microbiology teaching laboratories. Sandals & footwear with exposed skin are **NOT** allowed.
- For safety/ethical reasons, failure to comply will result in expulsion from the room
- Students that require gowns & gloves are **STRONGLY** recommended to have the vaccinations 1 to 11
